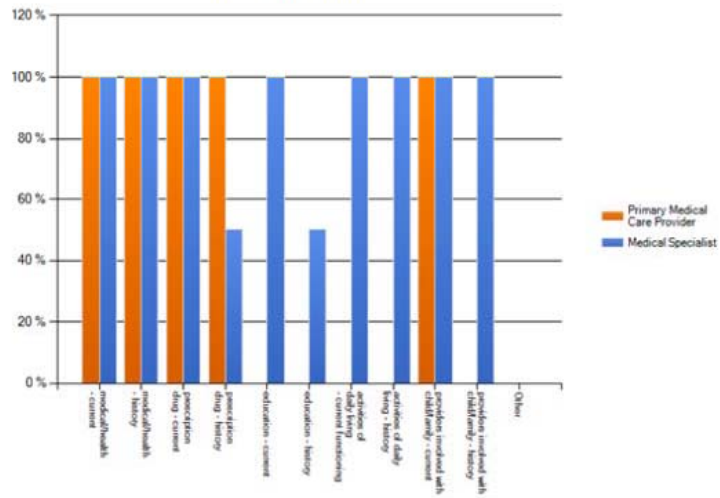


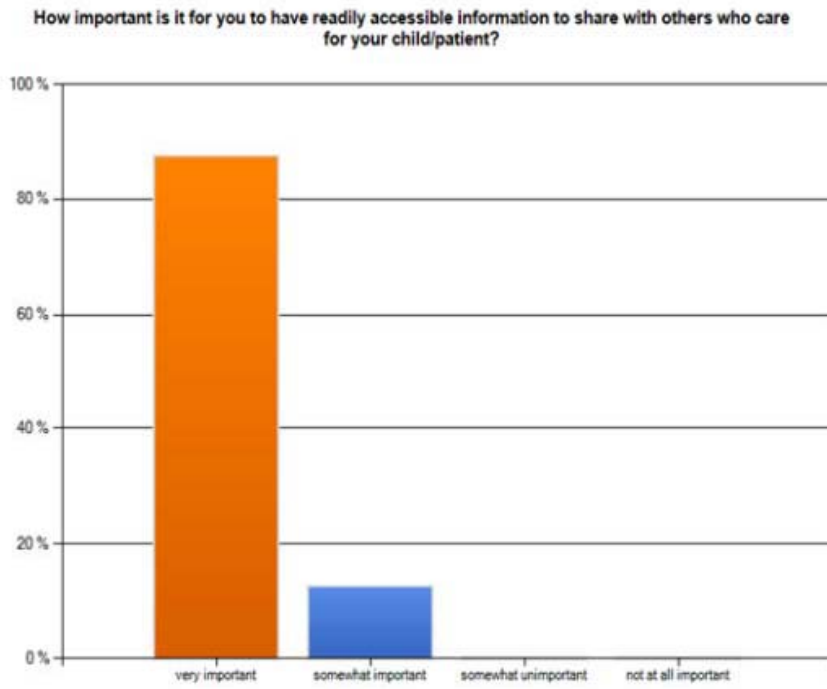


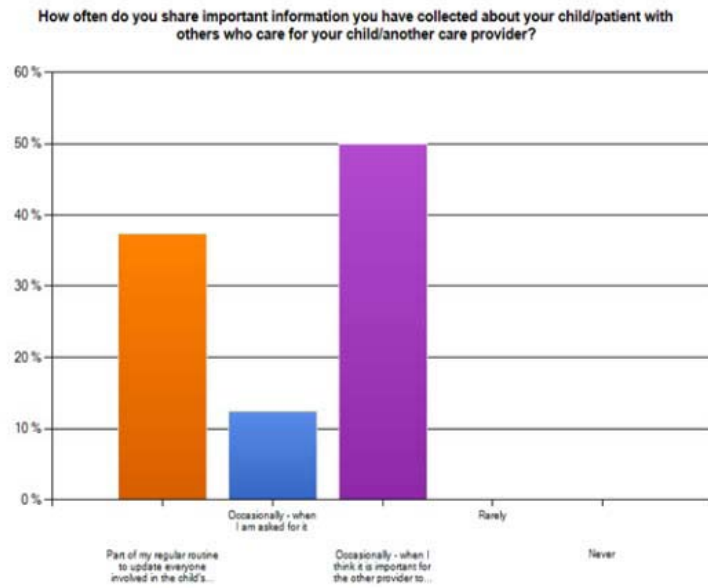
What types of information do you collect/track for your child/patient? (Choose all that apply)

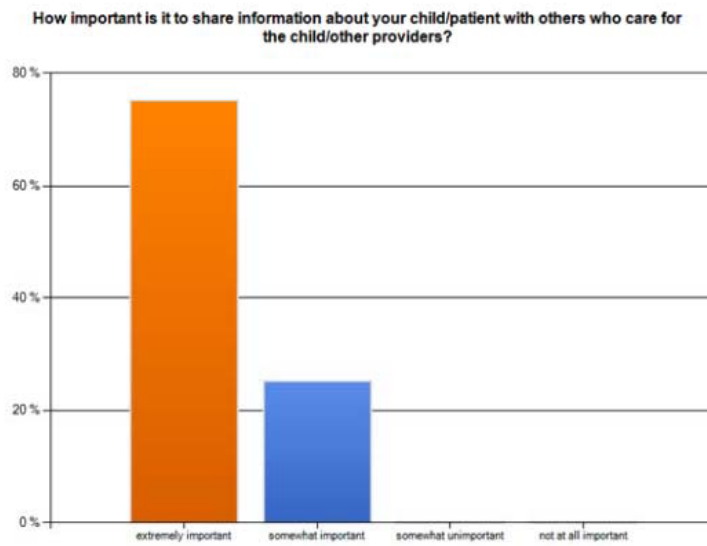


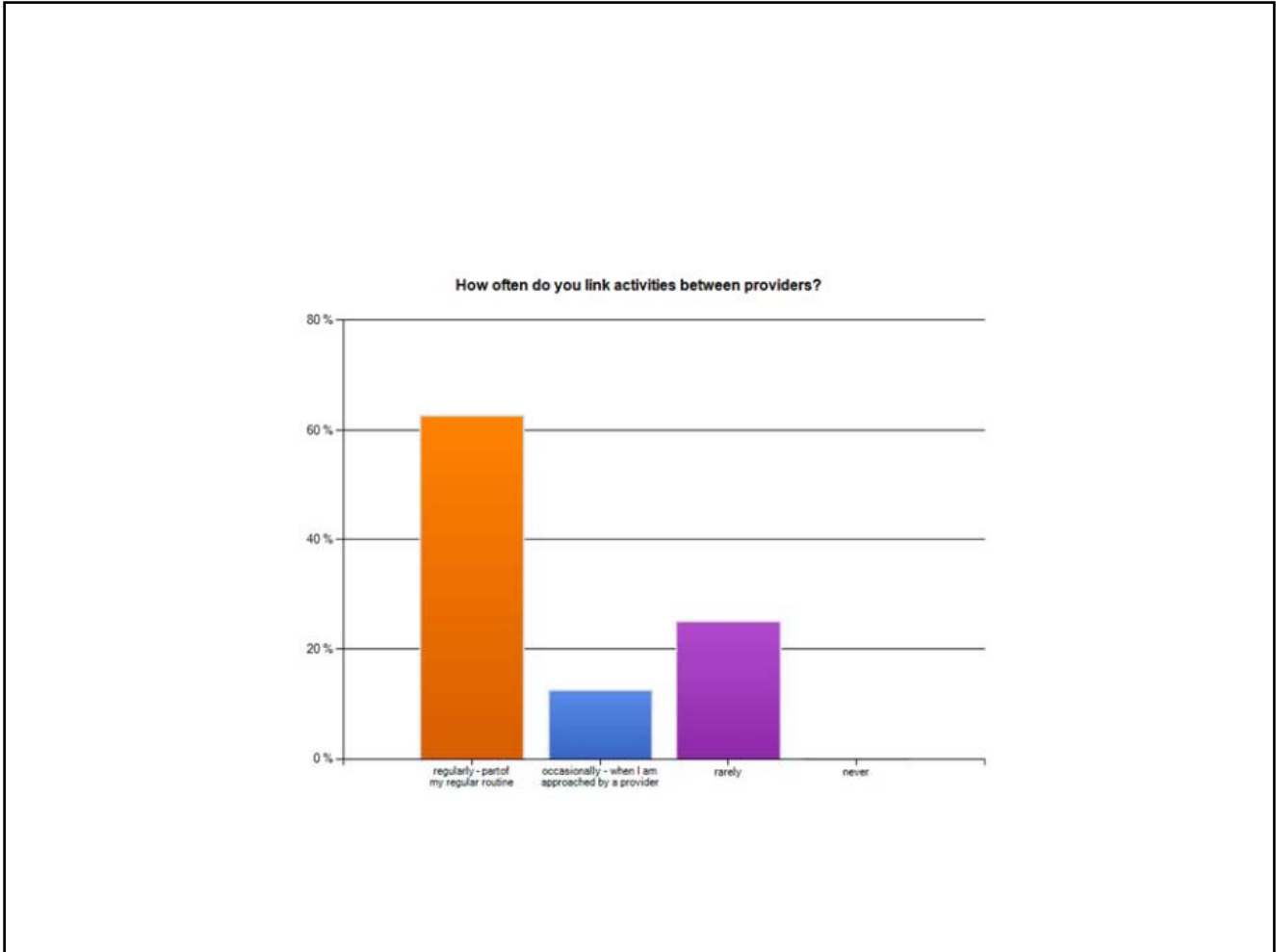




## Information Share
