CHEM 10

Calcium, chloride, CO₂, creatinine, glucose, magnesium, phosphorus, potassium, sodium, BUN

CHEM 12

Albumin, alkaline phosphatase, ALT, AST, total bili, calcium, chloride, CO₂, creatinine, glucose, potassium, total protein, sodium, BUN

CHEM 20

Albumin, alkaline phosphatase, ALT, AST, BUN, calcium, chloride, CO₂, creatinine, direct bili, total bili, GGT, glucose, LDH, phosphorus, potassium, sodium, total cholesterol, total protein, uric acid

Currently, we have lab test options on DocSite as: Chem 7 panel, Chem 12 panel, Chem 20 panel, **AND**, options to choose any of the individual tests associated with each of the above 4 panels with the exception of: LDH, uric acid, magnesium, phosphorus, total cholesterol, total protein, GGT. There is also an "other" option available to check.
